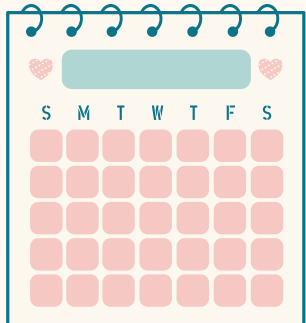




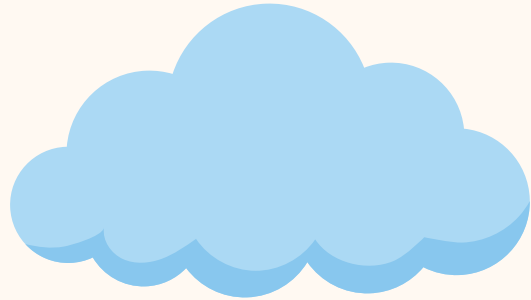
Including people with learning disabilities in your research:

Our top tips

Timing



March to October is an acceptable time for research interviews



Check the weather forecast ahead and on the day. It can affect my ability to take part



Provide refreshments and ask me if there is anything I cannot eat or do not like

Use an experienced facilitator



Documents



Use accessible information standards and no jargon



Adding your photo and information on who you are and what you do to all research documents and your email signature will help me to feel safe



Give me 3 weeks to process your study documents



Define research for me

Inclusion



Check if I need support to attend



Make sure the venue is accessible for everyone's needs. Book a venue that people already know.



Ask me how I can be involved



Ask me if I would like an interpreter



Ask me how I would prefer to receive payment for my involvement

Getting there

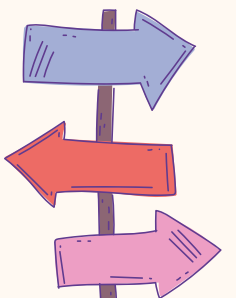


Check the venue has good public transport links

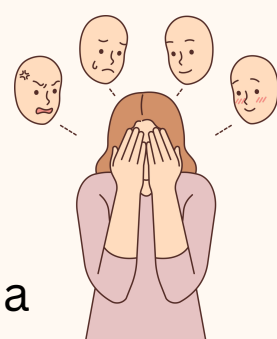


Allow enough time for me to get safely to and from the venue

Have a distress protocol

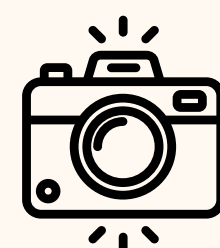


Use trigger warnings
